


# Hampshire SLS eBooks

smartphone




Download the ePlatform app by searching for 'ePlatform' within your device's app store.




Once installed, open the app and search for your school by clicking on 'Find your library':



Type the name of your school.  
Tap on your school name to select it:



This takes you to your school eBook library, where you can browse the library for an eBook to read:



You can either browse the titles on the home page or you can click 'Browse' to browse the catalogue:






The eBook will then launch automatically within the app for instant reading. Click on the right or left of the screen to turn the page:




# Tapping the middle of the screen to bring up the apps in Book options:
